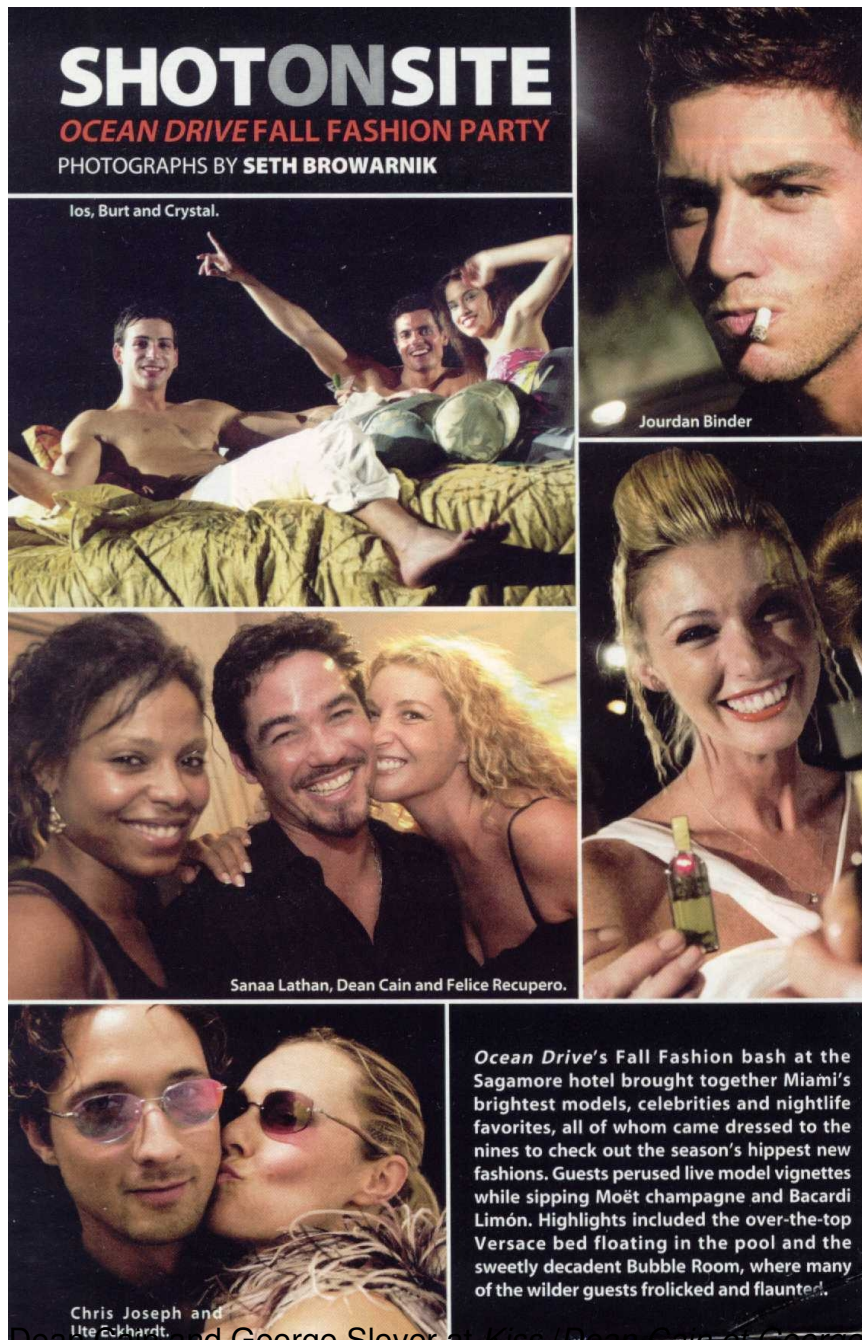

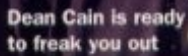

Dean Cain isn't Superman, he only played him on telly. Warners considered moving the cast to movies, but the idea quietly died along with the show.

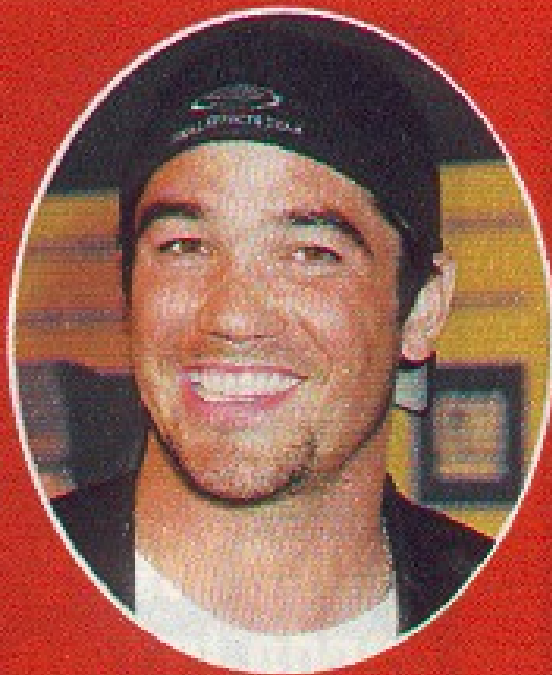
JOHN CUSACK

Did Dean Cain lie about his birthday?

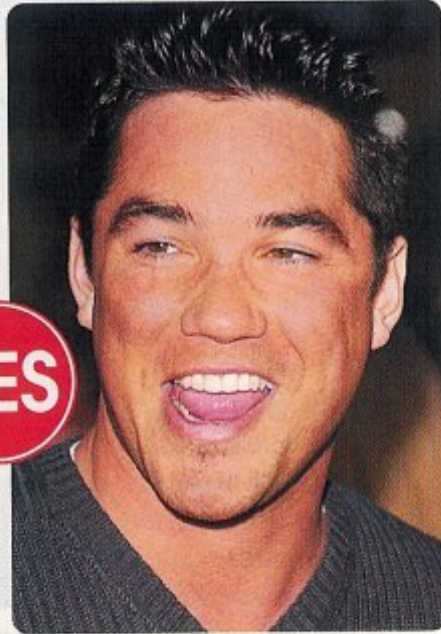
So much for Superman's motto of "truth, justice and the American way" – at least forget the "truth" part.
