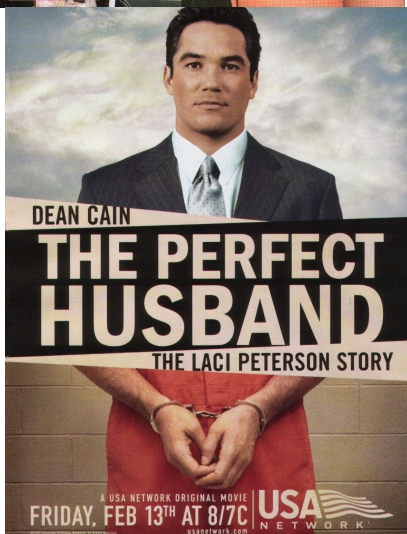

Dean Cain explores his dark side as accused murderer Scott Peterson in a chilling TV movie.

Dean Cain is used to being the good guy. So when the *Lois & Clark* producers and the script for *The Perfect Husband* told him to play Scott Peterson, "I wasn't sure I wanted to be associated with a person who has not engendered a lot of good feelings," the 37-year-old actor told *In Touch*. But it's a gamble that paid off. Cain is already generating Emmy buzz for playing the California man accused of murdering his eight-months-pregnant wife, Lori. Here, Cain talks about his tipped-down-the-headlines role, being lacerated by 3-year-old son Christopher (more on Dean's on-screen girlfriend Samantha, Terese), and whether he'll revisit the Man of Steel.

**After passing on playing Scott many times, why did you change your mind?**  
When I have tough decisions to make, I bounce them off my father. He said, "It's a good script. A complex character. Are you an actor?" I said, "Yes, sir." And he said, "Well, then, go on."

**Do you think Scott's guilty?**  
He did a lot of things that made him appear very guilty, but I played him innocent of murder because that's the way he portrayed himself.

**Your resemblance is eerie. How did you accomplish it?**  
I gained a little weight and grew a goatee. We did the hair to match. And I tried to affect his mannerisms to make it that much more convincing.

**Was your son scared of the new look?**  
He has on every movie we've been on. He understands Daddy's an actor.

**What if he wanted to be an actor?**  
The accident of chance is what he wants to do—even if he wants to be a cheerleader for the New York Jets.

**What do you two like to do together?**  
We spend most of our time with our three dogs and we just run around. It's great.

**Are you dating anyone right now?**  
I go out occasionally, but I'm not engaged. I had no 35-hour marriage in my future!

**Are you still in touch with your *Lois & Clark* co-star Teri Hatcher?**  
I've only seen her once since the show ended, at a coffee shop. Five or six years removed, here we are with a couple of kids between us and life is different. We had a pleasant, brief conversation.

**Rumor has it *Beyoncé* Knowles will play Lori Lane in the *Superman* movie.**  
I think that's wonderfully progressive. She's beautiful and talented, a little young to be Lori Lane, but what do I care?

**Would you do the fight again?**  
It's not a character I'm rushing to play again. But if they give me \$10 million, I'd go to work tomorrow.

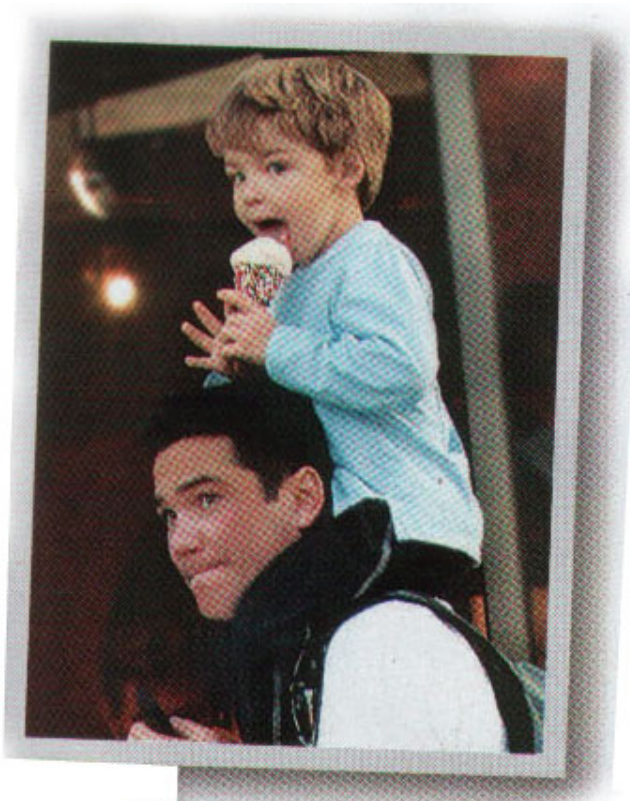
### The latest on Scott's trial

Scott Peterson was found guilty of murdering his wife and judge. The case has recently moved from Los Angeles to San Francisco and fears that the state's justice system could harm the chances of getting an impartial jury. Judge Albert A. DeLeoncio will hear the case after a previous judge was challenged by the prosecution. In his 13 years on the bench, DeLeoncio has issued no death sentences. Scott faces the death penalty if convicted.
